You can also be creative and choose some of the more challenging roles and topics and create a meaningful retelling of **slave life** by singing a **song** by **Tituba** addressed to other **slaves**.

You cannot make up things that have not happened; only use events and characters that exist within the confines of the play *The Crucible*. Be creative, have fun, but maintain accuracy and authenticity to the story!
